



# Ballantyne Junior Open



## Eligibility

Open to golfers age 13-18, boys & girls. (18 year-olds who are still attending high school will be eligible.) Ages for the tournament will be based on junior's age as of **February 13, 2010**.

## Condition

**Field:** The field will be limited to **64** Boys age 15-18, **16** Boys age 13-14 and **32** Girls age 13-18. **The field will be determined by the player's performance in the 2009 Ballantyne Junior Open, state ranking, national ranking, handicap and special exemption by the tournament committee.**

**Starting Times:** Shotgun start @ **10:00 am**. Hole assignment will be posted online at [www.danarader.com/BallantyneJuniorOpen.cfm](http://www.danarader.com/BallantyneJuniorOpen.cfm), **February 6, 2010**

**Rules:** Each competitor must walk and carry their own clubs. No caddies or pull-carts will be allowed during stipulated round.

**Spectators:** The committee welcomes spectators during the event. However, all spectators are required to walk along the cart paths or ride golf cart on the paths only and provide NO input into the play of the event, including rules.

**Locations:** The Golf Club at Ballantyne is conveniently located off I-485. Take Exit 61 (Johnston Rd.). Turn left at the second traffic light (Ballantyne Commons Parkway), then take your first left.

## Acceptance

All completely executed applications must be **received** by **Saturday January 23, 2010**. No entries will be accepted incomplete or after the deadline. The final field will be determined and posted online at [www.danarader.com/BallantyneJuniorOpen.cfm](http://www.danarader.com/BallantyneJuniorOpen.cfm) on **January 26, 2010**.

During the application process, applications received will be posted online but **does not guarantee** acceptance into the tournament. Any player withdrawing prior to the close of the entries will receive a full refund. Cancellation made after the closing date but more than 7 days before the tournament will be refunded less a \$30 processing fee. Cancellation made less than 7 days before the tournament will **not be refunded**.
